GHCTA Policy on Dogs and Motorized Vehicles

Note: GHCTA uses the USEA/USEF Rules as a guideline for all policies.

Due to safety issues that have been brought to the attention of the GHCTA Board of Directors, we want to clarify the policies on Dogs and Motorized Vehicles.

DOGS – ALL DOGS must be on a leash attached to a responsible human guardian capable of handling the dog at all times while on grounds. Dogs should be up to date on vaccinations and a record of such must be readily available should show management request proof of vaccines for any reason. Texas Law requires all dogs have a minimum of an annual rabies vaccine.

GHCTA Policy: There will be a fine of \$50/dog payable to the show organizer if a dog is found loose on grounds during the show/event. Offenders risk non-refundable elimination from the competition and impoundment of the dogs not in compliance.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES – the use of motorized vehicles at any venue is determined by the organizer/owner of that facility. Each venue shall post the policy for that venue/event on grounds and in the flyer for any show/clinic/event. Drivers of motorized vehicles must have a valid driver's license and be at least 18 years of age.

MeadowCreek Park Motorized Vehicle Policy: NO UNAUTHORIZED MOTORIZED VEHICLES are allowed on course. If special, medical or other circumstances require the use of a motorized vehicle on course, express permission must be granted by the Owner of the facility, and a permit will be issued. Owners and drivers of vehicles on course without a permit are subject to fines, removal from the premises and non-refundable elimination.

Please understand that both of these policies are meant to promote a safe environment for our competitors, their horses, their family, their helpers and our volunteers. We appreciate your respect of these policies.
